

Organisation

- (1) The Imokilly Hillclimb is organised and promoted by the Imokilly Motor Club Limited (hereinafter called the Promoters).
- (2) The event will take place on the 2.2Km Sweep in Dungarvan. It is our intention to give 4 runs.
- (3) These Regulations have been submitted to and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for the holding of the event has been granted. MI Permit No. **15 / 088**
- (4) The Competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and these supplementary regulations including "Appendices 80 of the current MI Yearbook. All competitors who forward completed Entry Forms agree to be bound by the rules.
- (5) Final Instructions form an integral part of the Supplementary Regulations.

Entries

- (1) All Entries must be made on the Official Entry Form accompanied by the appropriate entry fee and sent to: **Patsy Cashman, Cahermone, Midleton, Co. Cork.**

- (2) Postal Entries only will be accepted, incomplete or illegible entries will be returned.
- (3) Entries open on publication of these Regulations. Entries close on **Wednesday 10th June.**
- (4) The Entry Fee is €100. Cheques, Bank Drafts or Postal Orders should be made payable to Imokilly Motor Club Ltd.
- (5) Starters will be limited to 85 and will be taken on a first come first served basis.

Competitors

- (1) Driver. Only one person is allowed in a competition car at any time during the event, including the Paddock.
- (2) Class Eligibility. The onus will be on the competitor to ensure that they have been entered in the correct class. Please read the classes carefully before you fill in your entry form.
- (3) Double drive cars must display a sticker provided by the organisers. The sticker will be a black "D" on white background and must be placed on top of the windscreen, Single seaters must apply to the bodywork in front of the driver. **Note: Cars being double driven can only be entered into one class.**
- (4) Number must be clearly visible on both sides of the car. Competitors will be provided with a number by the organizers. Only the race number that you are running with on the event is to be visible on your car, all other numbers are to be covered up or removed. The onus is on double drivers to make sure that the correct number is on the car before they get to the start line.

Paddock

The Paddock will open at 7.30hrs on the morning of the event. There shall be no holding of spaces for any competitors. As you enter the hill you shall pull up behind the first vehicle you see, there shall be marshals observing this rule, you must at all times obey the paddock marshal's instructions. Double drivers shall be accommodated but will have to make themselves known to the paddock marshal who will have a list of the double drives. Waste bins will be provided in the paddock. A portaloos will be provided in the paddock.

Practice And Timed Runs

Each competitor must undertake one practice run and no practice re-runs will be allowed. Each competitor will be issued with run tickets - no ticket no run. **No competitor will be allowed drive the hill after the roads are closed.**

Start

Tyre warming of any type, whether spinning wheels before the start or using tyre warming blankets etc. is strictly prohibited. Where possible cars should run in class order and all single seaters should run together without saloon cars mixed among them. The onus is on each competitor to line up accordingly.

Finish

The finish line will be indicated by chequered flag boards. After crossing the finishing line competitors must reduce speed as quickly as possible within the distance of the 3-2-1 boards.

Holding Area

There will be a holding area at the top of the hill. Competitors must remain in the holding area until being escorted back to the paddock by the motorcycle marshal.

Results

Results will be published on the notice board after each timed run.

Notice Board

A notice board will be set up in the Paddock where final instructions, run results, etc. will be available for viewing during the event.

Classes

- Class 1A Production saloons up to 1400cc.
- Class 1B Fiat Cinquecento / Seicento Cars as per published technical regulations.
- Class 2 Production saloons from 1401cc up to 1650cc.
- Class 3A Production Saloons 1651 to 2050cc, Modified Production Saloons up to 2050cc, GT up to 1650cc and Sports Cars up to 1200cc.
- Class 3B Production/Modified Saloons and Rally Cars over 2050cc, GT Cars over 1650cc, Sports Cars 1201 to 2050cc and 4WD Rally Cars/Production Saloons.
- Class 4 Classic Cars per HRCA regulations. (See Appendix 49) & FIA Appendix K.
- Class 5 Formula Ford 1600 / Classic Formula Ford 1600 as per Ford Motorsport regulations & Formula Vee as MI appendix 45 regulations.
- Class 6 2050 Formula Libre. Single Seaters up to 2050cc having only one camshaft and Single Seaters up to 1650cc with two or more camshafts.
- Class 7 Libre / Sports Cars Unlimited and all other 4 wheel drive cars.
- Class 8 Rally cars up to 1650cc.
- Class 9 Rally cars 1651cc to 2050cc.

(The organisers reserve the right to add additional classes)

Definitions

Production Saloon: Bodyshell as per originally manufactured. Modified Production Saloon: Bodyshell modified from originally manufactured but no section may be spaceframed.
GT & Sports Car: Production and non-production GT and Kit Cars. Turbo/supercharged: cc x 1.7 applies to classes 1, 2, 3A, 3B, 6, 8, 9.

Licence Requirements

Minimum of National B Speed Licence is required with the exception of competitors competing in classes 3, 6, 7 and 9 which are required to have a minimum of a National A Speed licence.
