CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS 2017

1. Participants must be fully paid up members of IMC before the date of the event for which points are being claimed.
2. To be eligible for the 2017 championship, participants must be registered and fully paid up before 31st of March.
3. The 2017 championship will be based on a selected number of events as follows.

NT = Night Navigation Trial

T = Tarmac

LS = Loose Surface

Re-scheduled events will still qualify provided that the re-scheduled date is within the 2017 calendar year.

4. Scoring on the 2017 championship will be based on a competitors finishing position in his/her respective class on each event.

1st placed contender	15 Points
2nd placed contender	12 Points
3rd placed contender	10 Points
4th placed contender	9 Points
5th placed contender	8 Points
6th placed contender	7 Points
7th placed contender	6 Points
8th placed contender	5 Points
9th placed contender	4 Points
10th placed contender	3 Points

Any Club Member finishing lower than 10th Club Member in his/her respective class will be awarded Two Points. One point will be awarded if you start but fail to finish an event.

5. Bonus points will be awarded for finishing first, second or third in class in an event.
Three bonus points will be awarded for 1st in class.
Two bonus points will be awarded for 2nd in class.
One bonus point will be awarded for 3rd in class.
6. The 2017 championship will be decided on a competitors best 6 scores with a minimum of 3 starts required to qualify for an award.
7. Co-Drivers will score points based on his/her respective class position even if his/her driver is not registered for the championship.
8. Each day of a Two Day Rally i.e. West Cork & Cork "20" will count as separate events.
9. A separate class for Junior Competitors will run as part of the Club Championship.
10. Anyone that holds an Official position in the running of an event can claim 10 points for Club Championship as Driver or Navigator **(Points can be claimed for one event only)**
11. Participants in the 2017 Club Championship will be required to Marshal two days with the club during 2017 **(These are required to be Events included in the 2017 IMC Marshals' Championship and must be completed before the end of 2017 Club Championship).**
12. The championship co-ordinator or his delegates shall be responsible for calculating points.
13. In all cases points awarded are at the discretion of the championship co-ordinator.
14. A championship table will be published on the club website on the week after each event. Points will be provisional for 7 days after each publication. Following those 7 days, points to date will be declared final and no protest or query will be entered into. A championship table will also be available at the club meeting following each event. The onus is on each competitor to ensure he/she has been given the correct points.

15. Protests and queries about the awarding of points must be made to the championship coordinator.
16. The championship co-ordinator will decide protests and queries. If a participant is not satisfied with the decision made, then he/she may appeal through the club committee, whose decision is final.
17. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one with the greater number of higher placed class positions.
18. Trophies will be awarded annually at our awards night based on the previous calendar year's performances. All perpetual trophies remain the property of the club and must be returned eleven months after receipt, or sooner if requested by the committee.
19. Any competitor or competitor's crew bringing IMC into disrepute of any kind will be immediately excluded from the championship.

Awards.

The awards for the 2016 club championship will be as follows.

1st Overall Driver - Perpetual Shield & trophy. 1st Overall Co-Driver - Perpetual Shield & trophy.

2nd Overall Driver - Trophy. 2nd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

3rd Overall Driver - Trophy. 3rd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

1st Junior Driver - Trophy. 1st Junior Co-Driver - Trophy.

2nd Overall Driver - Trophy. 2nd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

3rd Overall Driver - Trophy. 3rd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

Additional Awards. Other trophies such as "Best New Donegal Forestry comer" and the "Fender-Bender" etc, may be awarded at the discretion of the club committee.
