CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS 2018

- 1) Participants must be fully paid up members of IMC before the date of the event for which points are being claimed.
- 2) To be eligible for the 2018 championship, participants must be registered and fully paid up before 31st of March.
- 3) The 2018 championship will be based on a selected number of events as follows.

27/28th January 1000 Isles Night Navigation Trial (NT)

3rd February Wm Loughman Forestry Rally (LS)

4th March Limerick Forestry Rally

17th/18th March West Cork Rally (T)

14th April Moonraker Forestry Rally (LS)

TBC Munster Autocross (LS)

3rd June Circuit of Munster Rally (T)

10th June Imokilly Autocross (LS)

24th June Ravens Rock Rally (T)

14th July Cavan Forrestry Rally (LS)

22rd July Imokilly Mini Stages Rally (T)

29th July Jim Walsh Cork Forestry (T)

29 – 30th Sept Cork "20" International Rally (T)

15th October Imokilly Autocross (LS)

28th October Fastnet Rally (T)

NT = Night Navigation Trial T = Tarmac LS = Loose Surface

4) Scoring on the 2018 championship will be based on a competitors finishing position in his/her respective class on each event.

Any Club Member finishing lower than 10th Club Member in his/her respective class will be awarded Two Points. One point will be awarded if you start but fail to finish an event.

5) Bonus points will be awarded for finishing first, second or third in class in an event.

Three bonus points will be awarded for 1st in class.

Two bonus points will be awarded for 2nd in class.

One bonus point will be awarded for 3rd in class.

6) Competitors finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd Overall will be awarded the following points:

1st O/A 25 Points 2nd O/A 22 Points 3rd O/A 20 Points

- 7) The 2018 championship will be decided on a competitors best 6 scores with a minimum of 2 starts required to qualify for an award.
- 8) Co-Drivers will score points based on his/her respective class position even if his/her driver is not registered for the championship.
- 9) Each day of a Two Day Rally i.e. West Cork & Cork "20" will count as separate events.
- 10) A separate class for Junior Competitors will run as part of the Club Championship.
- 11) Anyone that holds an Official position in the running of an <u>Imokilly Motor Club</u> event can claim 10 points for Club Championship as Driver or Navigator (Points can be claimed for one IMC event only)
- 12) Participants in the 2018 Club Championship will be required to:
 - i) Marshal two days with the club during 2018(These are required to be Events included in the 2018 IMC Marshals' Championship and must be completed before the end of 2018 Club Championship Bonus points do not count as a days Marshalling).
 - ii) Attend a minimum of two Club meetings. (Event Specific Meetings such as Rally meetings do not count)
- 13) The championship coordinator or his delegates shall be responsible for calculating points.
- 14) In all cases points awarded are at the discretion of the championship coordinator.

15) A championship table will be published on the club website on the week after each event. Points will be provisional for 7 days after each publication. Following those 7 days, points to date will be declared final and no protest or query will be entered into. A championship table will also be available at the club meeting following each event. The onus is on each competitor to ensure he/she has been given the correct points.

16) Protests and queries about the awarding of points must be made to the championship coordinator

17) The championship coordinator will decide protest and queries. If a participant is not satisfied with the decision made, then he/she may appeal through the club Directors

18) In the event of any appeals the results will remain provisional until the Directors have reached a decision.

19) In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one with the greater number of higher placed Class/Overall positions

20) Trophies will be awarded annually at our awards night based on the previous calendar year's performances. All perpetual trophies remain the property of the club and must be returned eleven months after receipt, or sooner if requested by the Directors and if returned in any condition that is not acceptable will be charged for repairs/restoration.

21) Any competitor or competitors crew bringing IMC into disrepute of any kind will be immediately excluded from the championship.

Awards.

The awards for the 2018 club championship will be as follows.

1st Overall Driver - Perpetual Shield & trophy. 1st Overall Co-Driver - Perpetual Shield & trophy.

2nd Overall Driver - Trophy. 2nd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

3rd Overall Driver - Trophy. 3rd Overall Co-Driver - Trophy.

1st Junior Driver - Trophy. 1st Junior Co-Driver - Trophy.

2nd Junior Driver - Trophy. 2nd Junior Co-Driver - Trophy.

3rd Junior Driver - Trophy. 3rd Junior Co-Driver - Trophy.

Additional Awards. Other trophies such as "Best Newcomer" and the "Fender Bender" etc, may be awarded at the discretion of the club Directors.
